**Bell ringing:** The Rev Vivien noted that bell ringing at St Giles was being grasped with renewed enthusiasm, with 17 regular ringers from the parish, supported with training by Vicky Chase and with Howard Pescott willing to fill the vacant role of Tower Captain, subject to the completion of necessary checks. The bell ringers were thanked for their contribution, particular for ringing to mark the Platinum Jubilee, the death of Queen Elizabeth II and the proclamation of King Charles III.
